The Cochran Adult Leader Association & Ag Advisory members are offering an Ag Youth Scholarship & Adult Leader Scholarship to eligible Cochran County 4H graduating seniors. There will be 2 Ag Youth Scholarships awarded in the amount of \$2000.00 each. There will be one Cochran Adult Leader Scholarship awarded in the amount of \$500.00.

To qualify, you must be, actively, participating in 4-H youth development programs sponsored and conducted by Texas A&M AgriLife Extension during part or all of the 2013-2014 4-H year. You must be a Texas resident and be scheduled to graduate from a Cochran County school during the 2013-2014 school year. You must make a formal application to enroll with intent to attend a college or university and have met the entrance requirements for that college or university. In addition, you must attend a scholarship interview on April 15<sup>th</sup> at 5 p.m. at the Activity Building, 200 W. Taylor St., Morton, TX, 79346. (Attire is professional dress or church clothes.)

Once enrollment for the chosen college, university or technical school has been provided and/or received, the scholarship payments will be provided as follows: Ag Youth Scholarship - \$1000.00 made, directly, to the recipient and \$1000.00 made, directly, to the institute. The Adult Leader scholarship \$500 amount made, directly, to the recipient.

Cochran County 4-H Scholarships are available only for students attending a college, university or technical institute. Failure to enroll and attend constitutes automatic forfeiture of the scholarship money. Please see other qualifications & guidelines provided with application. The application deadline will be March 28, 2014 at 12 p.m. All, **typed**, applications must be turned in to the Cochran Extension Office. An application has been enclosed for your convenience. - Must be active in the community and/or volunteer
- Must graduate with, at least, a “B” average - 80 or above
- Must enroll in an accredited college/university or trade school (where an associates degree is available)
- Must have taken the SAT or ACT unless not required by trade school
- Must provide proof of registration
- Must provide proof of full time status - 12 semester hours
- Must turn application in by designated deadline to the Cochran office
- Must provide a typed cover letter with a typed application
- Must attend scholarship interview by selection committee
- Eligibility for distribution will, only, be made during fall semester of recipient's freshman enrollment after registration verification has been made
