A reminder at the start of this 4-H year - all volunteers are to be rescreened every three years. For 4-H volunteers, the need for rescreening is determined on a 4-H year basis. For example, a volunteer screened any time between September 1, 2008 and August 31, 2009 needs to be re-screened at the beginning of this 2011-2012 4-H year.
